First established under the authority of Public Law 480, the FMD was re-au-thorized by Title VII of the Agricultural Trade Act of 1978, and is administrated by USDAs Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS). The program has fostered a cost-sharing trade promotion partnership between USDA and U. S. agricultural producers and processors, who are represented by non-profit commodity or trade associations called Cooperators. FAS enters into partner-ships with those eligible nonprofit U. S. trade organizations that have the broadest producer representation of the commodity being promoted. Under this partnership, USDA and the Cooperators pool their technical and financial resources to conduct overseas market development. How the program benefits U. S. agriculture: The FMD benefits U. S. farmers, processors, and exporters by assisting their organizations in maintaining or increas-ing market share in existing markets by addressing long-term foreign market im-port constraints and by identifying new markets or new uses for the agricultural commodity or product in the foreign market.
